 - ii. A small dip in the Intermediate School scores that is to be expected with the implementation of the new ELA curriculum
 - iii. Generally, good news all around. We are moving in the right direction
 - iv. Looking to Implement a pre ACT test given to the juniors - it is a written test - a little shorter than the actual ACT - scores will be back in two weeks - information gained from the pre ACT test will be used to help students prepare for the ACT.
 - b. Attendance Initiative (K-12) - new position in the District this year - RTI Specialist. Working with parents, social media marketing, mentors
