*Intermediate School - 110 virtual first quarter - 50 coming back for 2nd quarter.

5. Middle School Update

*7th Grade Social Studies - Election talk - why wasn't there any discussion of this? Unfortunately, with the new curriculum, we tried to integrate the book the kids are reading in ELA into the Social Studies curriculum and that was the fit where everything landed.

*We are in our 10th week very pleased with all the COVID procedures being followed.

*To date, we've had 5 COVID positive cases.

*66 virtual learning students are coming back this quarter.
