- Administrative Report Update (Mr. Olson)
  - a. Tik Tok Challenge going on with the kids we are sending out letters to parents to let then know the situation We are addressing kids and letting them know to do the right thing.
  - b. Covid Update Our main thing is to keep kids in school safely. Last year we had 96 positives + 716 close contacts resulting in 7160 lost instructional school days (7 of the students tested positive). This year so far we have had 26 positives, 45 close contacts, 450 lost instruction days (2 tested positive). Looking at changing things up at the end of the quarter one option may be to still do the contact tracing and calling the parents and asking them if they would like to have their child sent home other options will be explored throughout the rest of the quarter.
  - c. We are looking at introducing rapid covid testing to the district.
  - d. What's your Plan is continuing to throughout the District always encouraging kids to look at plans for a future and be college and career ready.
  - e. Facility Planning Survey is out to the community asking for input on a referendum due back October 18th. HAC Committee will look at results and come up with a plan based on the results of the survey.
  - f. What is going on with the DARE program? At this time law enforcement does not have the personal to run this program. We are still doing everything we can to cover the issues during classes and educating our kids.



- g. Football Realignment still working on it. Olson now sits on the WIAA Realignment Task Force that will look into this.
