2. Administrative Report Update (Mr. Olson) -
 - a. Referendum ballot language has been submitted
 - i. The district's role is to provide facts only.
 - ii. Outside groups may be formed. Vote yes or vote no.
 - b. Security Issues before Christmas break - Social Media threats about something bad that would happen at school. Administration worked all night with local law enforcement and no viable threats were found. We had additional officers on duty during the school day. We updated the public as soon as we had factual information.
3. Curriculum Updates (Mrs. Ryder)
 - a. The School Board gave direction on forming a Health Advisory Committee. A 20 member committee was agreed upon. We have 41 parent volunteers and will be doing a lottery drawing to form the committee.
 - i. There are stipulations from DPI on the number of members from each category that can be on the committee. More information will be coming soon.
 - b. District Report Card will be presented with the information at the Jan 17 board meeting. We can tell you we did meet expectations. High school for the first time exceeded expectations. Intermediate School exceeded expectations again this year.



- c. State assessment dates are getting set up. We hope to be done by Easter break. The ACT is the first assessment to be administered.
