2. Administrative Report Update (Mr. Olson) -
  - a. Building Project Update - Bid process is complete. KA did an awesome getting bids - the personal service is making getting things go smoothly. A group went and visited the furniture store and talked to the schools that are currently using it - time well spent, we learned lots of do and don'ts. March 6th is the guaranteed Maximum Pricing on the bid process. The next step is coordinating the moves in all the buildings.
  - b. Summer School - Flexibility is the key with all the remodeling going on. As soon as we know what the move looks like and the student numbers we will get the busing and room assignments ready.
  - c. School Safety - Be the One initiative - we are getting a clear message out throughout the district. Going well.
    - i. Security Cameras - updated cameras and additional cameras with all the wiring will be added through the remodel. The new camera system will be able to alert us if a door has been propped open.
    - ii. Fentanyl Awareness - working with local law enforcement to raise awareness in our community and schools.
    - iii. Additional School Resource Officer - working with Chief Clapero to post this position. We are not positive how this will look next year, but we are working on getting an additional resource officer.
  - d. ACHIEVE - Looking at ways to keep all our programs going.



- i. At Risk of graduating program- working on individual plans to get each student to graduate.
    - ii. Before and Afterschool possibilities - we are looking at adding a before and after school program next year. Our goal is not to compete with local community programs but to increase opportunities for parents.
  - e. Community Engagement - Our job fair went well. It was great to bring community employers in to meet with our students.
    - i. School to Work Program - Students presented at the school board meeting outlining what they are doing in the community. Looking to expand that program
    - ii. Name/Branding with the new remodel. People in the community want to donate and we'd like to recognize that.
    - iii. Customer Service Mindset - our job when someone has a question is to answer it in a timely manner. We are doing a decent job but are working to get better at this.
    - iv. Snow Day Update - It is always a challenge to call the days. Right now we are 4 hours short in all our schools - we are looking at ways to fix this.

  - a. March 7 is the ACT test for Juniors - that is a day just for juniors at the high school
  - b. Freshmen and Sophomores will take the Pre-ACT in April - TBD
  - c. Forward testing is being set up in the buildings
